Twenty-five (25) years ago, as an earthquake-like tragedy, the so-called Islamic Regime, conquered my homeland and destroyed the foundations and the future of all Iranians, in particular the young generation. Since then, International isolation, export of hate and terror, inflation, unemployment, corruption, drug addiction, and human rights abuse has become the legacies of the clerical regime.

The clear intent of the Islamic Republic of Iran for forcing the young generation into this terrible state is to control their lives and to distract them from caring about their future.
